

POLICY FOR CONTINUING SPECIAL EDUCATION FOR
STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES AGE 19 THROUGH 22

Students with disabilities who have reached the age of nineteen before the beginning of a new school year are eligible for consideration for continuing special education through the conclusion of the school year in which they turn 22 as determined by the case conference committee.

As a part of making such a determination the case conference committee shall review:

- A. The Individual Transition Plan (ITP) of the student.
- B. Progress the student has made and goals and objectives of the student's Individualized Education Program (IEP).
